We need volunteers to participate in a research study to help us determine if mTBI might be a risk factor for Alzheimer's disease

Dr. Nejtek at UNT Health Science Center is conducting a research study to determine

risks for Alzheimer's disease in **veterans** versus **healthy controls**. There is only **one** research study visit taking **about 1-hour and 45-minutes** of your time. No medications or interventions will be given.

To determine eligibility:

- ❖ One 10-minute **phone screen**
- ❖ One 10-minute **in-person screen** where additional questions will be asked plus:
 - ◆ Urine sample to rule out drug use & pregnancy
 - ◆ Breathalyzer to rule out current alcohol use

If you meet the in-person criteria, you will be invited to enroll in the study.

Eligible study participants will be:

1. Interviewed to collect demographic, health & military information
2. Assessed to measure brain functioning, symptoms, mood status & cognition
3. Provide a blood sample (about 4 teaspoons)

Who is Eligible?

- Healthy participants with **no military experience** & have had **no head injuries** in the past 6 years
- Adults between the ages of **25-45 years old**
- African American/Black, Hispanic or Non-Hispanic White
- Have a **high school diploma** or GED

Study participants who complete all study procedures and assessments will be **compensated**
