Good morning,

Construction will begin soon to add another deck to <u>Garage 5</u>, increasing campus parking capacity by creating 200 additional spaces. The garage, located between Clifton Drive and the Center for BioHealth and adjacent to the new Interdisciplinary Research and Education Building, will also receive a new façade.

During this construction, about 200 Garage 5 parking spaces will be out of service when construction begins in early February and continues until early summer.

To ensure everyone who holds a general parking permit has a place to park, UNTHSC will pay for 200 additional parking spaces in the Will Rogers Memorial Center <u>parking garage and surface parking lot</u> closest to campus from Feb. 10 until May 31.

In the spirit of <u>One University and Our Values</u>, most <u>President's Cabinet</u> members will park at Will Rogers during this time.

In addition, the Cabinet is inviting about 200 additional volunteers who hold general parking garage and surface lot permits to park in the Will Rogers lot during those four months. Though the Will Rogers parking is more expensive than campus parking, volunteers will not be charged an additional fee.

"As One University, I believe we are all in this together," said Greg Anderson, Executive Vice President of Finance and Operations.

Lot hours will be 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. On a few select days when Will Rogers has major events and parking won't be available, volunteers will be able to park at the Dickie's Arena Garage and take shuttle buses to and from campus.

If you have a general parking garage or surface lot permit and would like to volunteer to park at the Will Rogers parking garage or surface lot from Feb. 10 until May 31, just email parking@unthsc.edu.

## Other parking improvements on the way

- Resetting parking space counters in all garages more often to improve accuracy.
- Publishing student testing schedules in advance so everyone can see when there may be large numbers of students parking on campus.

- Making sure <u>Premium Surface Lot 6</u> is used efficiently. Although sold out, many spaces remain vacant during the day.
- Repurposing three <u>ParkMobile</u> spots in Lot 1 near the Health Pavilion for clinicians who work both off-site and on campus on any given day.
